

## II CONFERENCE OF YOUNG RESEARCHERS IN THE HISTORY OF NAVARRRE

### Call for Applications. Guidelines

**Date and venue:** Friday, November 13, 2026, morning and afternoon sessions at the Royal and General Archive of Navarra.

**Target participants:** final-year undergraduate students, master's and PhD students, and professionals in the fields of teaching, research, archiving and heritage management who have new insights to contribute regarding the history of Navarra, aged under 35.

**Registration:** Registration will be completed via a form available on the SEHN website (<https://sehn.org.es/>).

**Registration fee:** €20. The registration fee includes, in addition to participation in the conference and the publication of papers, one year's membership of the SEHN, coffee breaks and lunch. The registration fee will only be payable if the proposal is accepted.

**Theme:** Open to all periods and all fields related to the History of Navarra, including Art, Law, Music, Linguistics, Literature, as well as Navarra's relations with other regions.

**Organization:** The conference will be structured into different panels according to theme, each chaired by a moderator who will give a brief introduction to the selected papers. Each speaker will have approximately 15 minutes to present their paper.

## Requirements for submitting proposals

1. Paper proposals must be submitted using a form that includes the title, the author's name, their institutional or professional affiliation, and an email address.
2. In addition, applicants must attach a document containing a 300-word abstract of the proposal with 5 keywords, as well as another document with a brief CV.
3. Deadline for submission of proposals: September 13, 2026. By the end of September, applicants will be notified whether their proposals have been accepted or not.
